- **Wonder of the Honey Bees: June 1st 11am - 1pm**
 - Hands on beekeeping workshop, beginner beekeepers welcome, all equipment provided. Participants must wear closed toed shoes, light colours and long sleeves are recommended. Honey bee biology, communication, lifecycle and management: how the super-organism of the colony works. Outdoors at the DCC Apiary!
- **Pollinators in the Garden: June 29th 1 - 3pm**
 - Hands on pollinator workshop, all ages welcome. Participants must wear closed toed shoes, light colours and long sleeves are recommended. Observe the pollinator meadow around the DCC Apiary, discuss pollinator habitat and forage and how you can support all pollinators in your own garden. Observe the honey bees and learn about their work of pollination and how they make honey in the process.
- **Hands on Sustainable Beekeeping: July 18th 4 - 6pm**
 - Hands on beekeeping workshop, beginner beekeepers welcome, all equipment provided. Participants must wear closed toed shoes, light colours and long sleeves are recommended. - **Beekeeping SOS and overwintering: August 10th 10am - 12pm**
 - This beginning and intermediate beekeeper workshop covers how to assess beehives for successful overwintering. We discuss honey stores/feeding, mite treatments, and winter insulation. We will also leave time to address problems from the group. Participants will leave with a calendar of important beekeeping dates to remember and will be able to reach us through our email to ask further questions or advice.
