- June 2021: Sarah Common from H4H to present- **Beekeeping for Healthy Bees**

How can we support the health of pollinators in the spring, in the way we work in our gardens in the fall? Many of us have been trained to keep tidy gardens, free of plant debris, but as our eyes open to all the kinds of pollinators visiting our gardens, and their needs for habitat as well as forage, we can start to understand that wilder gardens are pollinator havens! Join us to learn tips and tools, as we share our own practices - intro level, all welcome!
